Dear Ms. Stetzer:

I am writing to inform you that we have received an application for a bus stop from UTWT Bus Lines, Inc. The proposed location is in front of 14 Allen Street, east side of the street, between Canal and Hester Streets. We are asking for comments from the Community Board on this proposed inter-city bus stop within 45 days of the date of this letter (May 1st). Below are the details.

- The stop would be in front of 14 Allen Street, east side of the street, between Canal and Hester Streets
- The bus operator is UTWT Bus Lines, Inc.
- The proposed location is an 89 feet long bus stop for Eastern Coach & No. 1 Bus Tour. The rest of the block is night street cleaning and 1-hour muni meter parking regulation. This will be a shared stop
- There will be 1 pick-up and 1-drop-off, Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 1:30 AM and 2:30 AM
- The bus will travel from New York City to Atlanta, Georgia
