


Bike Corral Application



Bike Corral at Broadway and West 105th St. Maintained by Henry's Restaurant.

DOT installs bike corrals to accommodate high demand for bike parking in areas with insufficient space on the sidewalk for racks. Instead of installing a single bike rack on the sidewalk, bike corrals are installed in the curbside lane of the street and typically accommodate between 4 and 10 racks. Bike corrals are often installed designated "No Parking" or "No Standing Anytime" areas, or in a parking space.

Applicants agree to maintain the space by keeping the corral clear of snow and debris and reporting abandoned bikes.
