From a residential in Queens bounded on the north by 32nd Avenue from College Point Blvd. to 160th Street, bounded on the east by 160th Street from 32nd Avenue along Rose Avenue following Kissena Blvd. to Long Island Expressway bounded on the south by the Long Island Expwy. from Kissena Blvd. to College Point Blvd. bounded on the west by College Point Blvd. from Long Island Expressway to 32nd Ave. From and to said territories to Chinatown in Manhattan, bounded on the north by Delancey Street/Kenmare Street from Broadway to Essex Street, bounded on the east by Essex Street from Delancey Street to East Broadway, bounded on the south by East Broadway from Essex Street along Worth Street to Broadway, Bounded on the west by Broadway from Worth Street along Broome Street following Centre Street to Kenmare Street/Delancey Street.

Any written comments received after this date may not be considered. Those opposing the application must clearly specify why the proposed expansion of vans will not meet present and/or future public convenience and necessity.
