







Early design elevation for courthouse building ca. 1913
















PARTIAL ELEVATION AT LIBRARY ADDITION




WALL SECTION AT LIBRARY ADDITION




PROPOSED BUILDING SECTIONS






PROPOSED GROUND FLOOR PLAN






