January 2002 Resolutions

At its January 2002 monthly meeting, Community Board #3 passed the following motions:

TITLE: LESC Methadone Clinic

To request that LES Service Center make best effort to set up an advisory board comprised of community residents and a community board member as well as to develop a community outreach plan and hire Chinese speaking employees for the current methadone clinic at 33 Division Street and to support offer by State Senator Duane to bring the community and Lower East Side Service Center together to start the process of creating a representative community advisory board.

TITLE: LES Tenement Museum Expansion Civic Project, 99 Orchard St.

That, while appreciating the valuable work of the Tenement Museum, Community Board #3 opposes the ESDC's condemnation proceeding against 99 Orchard based on fact that Eminent Domain is not the appropriate vehicle to displace existing land owner and residents for the purpose of expanding museum.

TITLE: Lower Eastside Business Improvement District (LESBID)'s Renovation Proposal for Allen Street Mall (Broome to Delancey Streets)

To approve the proposal by LESBID for renovation of Allen Street Mall (Broome to Delancey Streets) by DPR, as a pilot and on the condition that DPR will return to Community Board #3 before any plans are drawn for renovation/design of additional Allen Street mall; and that this mall will be part of the Greenstreets Maintenance Program.

TITLE: No Parking Anytime Sign (Lewis at Broome Street)

That Community Board #3; in the interests of providing clear emergency vehicle access at this driveway, approve "No Parking Anytime" signage on the West Side of Lewis Street at Broome Street to replace the current "Alternate Side Parking" restriction starting at the Lamp pole located at 550 J Grand Street (on Lewis Street) and going North to the start of the "School Parking Only" signage currently in effect for PS 110.

TITLE: Parking Signage on Avenue C and East 8th Street

To approve POLICE PARKING ONLY signage directly in front of (and not opposite of, or near) the building area of the new PSA4 on Avenue C and East 8th Street and...

To request that DOT not make any future signage changes in the vicinity of this facility without the review and approval of Community Board #3.

TITLE: TLC License Renewal for B.O.B. Express, Inc., 32 Market Street, New York, NY 10002 (B01631)

To approve the application by B.O.B. Express, Inc. for renewal of the TLC license (B01631) for a For-Hire Base at 32 Market Street.

TITLE: TLC License Renewal for City Lincoln Car & Limousine Service, Inc. 276 Grand Street, Room 201, New York, NY 10002 (B01415)

To approve the application by City Lincoln Car & Limousine Service, Inc. for renewal of the TLC license (B01415) for a For-Hire Base at 276 Grand Street because the applicant, on the date of the Full Board meeting, brought notarized proof of Garage space for vehicles and a document signed by the drivers that they are to follow traffic regulations and stay away from the base area.

TITLE: Bus Shelter for 3rd Street and Avenue A

That DOT place a Bus Shelter at NE corner of 3rd Street and Avenue A.

TITLE: Bus Shelter replacement on 1st Avenue and East 1st Street

To urge DOT to revisit the need for replacing the bus shelter at the NE corner of 1st Avenue and East 1st Street for the M15 bus service. This shelter is particularly useful and appreciated by the senior citizens residing in Meltzer Houses (1st Street between 1st Avenue and Avenue A). The replacement shelter could be smaller and therefore less intrusive on a sidewalk.

TITLE: PSA #4, 8th Street (C - D)

That NYPD issue a letter to Community Board #3 assuring us that they will not turn on the floodlights at the new PSA4 facility unless there is an emergency.
