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March 2002 Resolutions

At its March 2002 monthly meeting, Community Board #3 passed the following motions:

TITLE: Lease Extension for The Children's Liberation Daycare Center

That P.S. 122 Community Center approve a lease extension with The Children's Liberation Daycare Center (TCLDC) so they can qualify for ACS Capital funding earmarked for a much needed kitchen renovation including fixing an unsafe stove condition and...

That TCLDC's services for children and families should never be impinged on by other groups using the P.S. 122 Community Center. and...

That the Board supports TCLDC's efforts to find way to expand its program of recreational, educational and child care activities, in keeping with P.S. 122 Community Center's original charter mandate.

TITLE: Same Sex Civil Unions

To support same sex civil unions in New York State; and (2) to request our U.S. Senators and Representatives to repeal the "Defense of Marriage Act".

TITLE: Lower East Side Service Center Advisory Committee

That LESSC should organize a community advisory committee (CAC) and...

That the Board is dismayed at LESSC's failure to attend our Housing Committee meeting and...

That our member, Echo Wong, will be Community Board #3's representative to the (CAC) as soon as it is established.

TITLE: Cooper Square's Urban Renewal Plan

To reiterate support for the Cooper Square's Urban Renewal Plan, to request that HPD allow all prior tenants and occupants to submit proposals for occupancy of the new community facility under the terms of the RFP, and to encourage HPD to consider Lower East Side community groups for tenancy of new community space in the Renewal Plan.

TITLE: Taoist Temple Relocation

To encourage HPD to assist the Taoist Temple in its relocation.

TITLE: Bus Service Expansion for Crosstown Grand Street Bus Shuttle

That Community Board #3 reiterate its support for, and request for, both the implementation of the Bus portion of the MESA plan with the proviso that the M-21 not be eliminated but enhanced and...

That, in the interim, the current "temporary" Grand Street Bus Shuttle be immediately expanded into a cross-town Bus with special attention to potential problems caused by, and the need for enforcement against, the illegal commuter vans and buses in the areas to be served.

TITLE: Inadequate Park Funding in Budget

To oppose the inadequate funding for parks in preliminary budget, i.e., a 13% cut this year.

TITLE: Bella Tile and Mosque Parking Condition

To ask that the Islamic Council of America, Inc. meet with Bella Tile and their neighbors (including 1st Avenue from 10th to 13th Streets) to arrive at a mutually agreeable solution to the traffic congestion problems on 11th Street and that in the interim the Mosque regularly ask their Congregation to cooperate by parking in accordance with NYS and NYC Traffic Laws.

TITLE: Second Avenue Subway Task Force

To approve the resolution of the Second Avenue Subway Task Force.

TITLE: Street Vendors, Quality of Life

To create a Task Force to resolve the quality of life and health and safety issues cause by street vendors presently located outside Confucius Plaza on Division Street. This committee or task force will include public members for public participation, elected officials and representatives of PS 124, relevant city agencies, and nearby merchants.
