The DDC is reconstructing/replacing combined sewers, trunk main, water mains, catch basins, fire hydrants, sidewalks, trees, as well as, two 'Green Street' parks

Work Completed on East Houston St.

- Granite Curbs, pigmented Sidewalks and roadway base concrete, have all been installed, between Orchard St. and Chrystie St.
- Granite Curbs and pigmented Sidewalks have also been installed from Chrystie St. to the Bowery
- Center medians have been installed and planted between Orchard St. and Chrystie

Work in progress on E. Houston St

- Build a safety Island at 2nd Avenue
- Continue relocating the utility at the Bowery so the new Trunk main can be installed and completed.
- Excavating and installing a 20" Distribution water main west of the intersection of East Houston St. & Chrystie St.

Proposed Work Schedule, First Quarter of 2017

- Install additional median between Christie St, and the Bowery.
- **Special Note:** M15 Bus stop will be returned to its original stop on Allen Street. NYCT buses will select the date for return.
- Two trash receptacle to be placed in each of the green streets park areas
