Houston and Chrystie St./2 <sup>nd</sup> Ave.	The contractor is scheduled to start excavating and start the installation for a new blow-off valve and 20" distribution water main, then build a center safety Island on 2 <sup>nd</sup> Ave. which will complete the underground work at 2 <sup>nd</sup> Ave.	7:00AM to 6:00PM (Day work)
