DDC BEGINS WATER MAIN REPLACEMENTS AND DISTRIBUTION OF WATER MAIN EXTENSIONS AT VARIOUS MANHATTAN LOCATIONS

Various Community Board 3 Locations

Please be advised that on or about April 6, 2015, The New York City Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) will begin Water Main Replacements and Distribution of Water Main Extensions at various Manhattan locations, **weather and field conditions permitting.** The purpose of this project is to enlarge existing water mains to service more New Yorkers, as well as replace older water mains to improve the quality of water service.

WHERE WILL WORK BE PERFORMED?

Work will be performed on:

- ➤ Entire Project limits:
 - o On Delancey Street between Pitt Street and Columbia Street
 - o On Pitt Street between Delancey Street and East Houston Street
 - o On Rivington Street between Pitt Street and Clinton Street
 - o On the East Side of Bowery between Canal Street and East 4th Street
- > Tentatively:
 - o On First and Second Streets between Bowery and Second Avenue
 - o On Second Avenue between East Houston Street and Second Street

WHAT ARE THE COMMUNITY IMPACTS?

DDC is committed to maintaining a work site that is safe and clean. However, dust, noise and heavy equipment are common elements of construction and we ask for your patience during the project. In order to facilitate the construction, there may be limited street access on certain blocks. However, deliveries to commercial/residential properties and emergency vehicle access will be allowed. Please contact the Community Construction Liaison to coordinate.

Pedestrian Access/ Parking

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- > Temporary street closures and / or limited access may be necessary
- Uniformed NYPD traffic agents assigned for traffic control
- DDC will monitor operation and work within DEP Noise Code regulations
- > Sidewalk and/or loading dock access from the curb may be temporarily restricted while work is conducted (coordination will be arranged on a case by case basis)
- > Parking may be temporarily restricted during construction

Water Service Interruptions

➤ A 72- hour notice will be provided throughout the affected project area along with instructions on how to prepare for the water service interruption. A 24-hour confirmation/cancellation will follow and will be distributed/posted to any/all affected location(s).

WHAT ARE THE WORK HOURS?

Allowable work hours are Monday through Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm, as well as night work hours from 10:00pm to 6:00am as needed. No weekend work anticipated. Advanced notification will be given if construction deviates from these scheduled hours.
