Reality of Sound Transmission Class (STC).

STC is a method of rating airborne sound transmission performance of a wall or floor assembly. It is intended as a quick screening tool to compare different wall or floor assemblies. STC ratings are determined in a laboratory under controlled conditions. Even then, differences of 1-2 points STC can occur for the same assembly in the same laboratory. In the field, flanking noise, quality of material and construction practices can lead to widely varied STC's for the same assembly. Typically a two (2) or more point change in STC is necessary to notice an audible difference.

Product Comparison

Independent ÅSTM E90-1990 testing was used to determine Sound Transmission Class in accordance with ASTM E413 for several types of building insulation. All the testing was done at the same lab, using the same individually tested components, to give the most reproducible results. The results show that insulating the cavity is critical to acoustic performance. It also shows that the type of insulation does not significantly affect the performance of the assembly.

Design Considerations

Acoustical performance of metal stud interior partitions can be substantially affected by a number of important design and construction details. Important details include:

 Seal the bottom plate and any wall penetrations with nonhardening permanently resilient sealant.

WALLS

When it comes to noiseproofing walls, you first must decide whether to work with the existing walls (nondestructive upgrading), or to tear out existing walls (destructive upgrading). Destructive upgrading is more effective, but it costs more and requires more time. The choice is yours.

Here are some wall noiseproofing tips:

- Remove direct air paths between rooms by sealing cracks covered by wall trip, unsealed doors, and pathways
 that involve the ventilation system.
- Add an extra layer of drywall with Green Glue Noiseproofing Compound. Just adding a drywall layer alone only improves a wall's STC rating by 2 points. Adding a double drywall improves the STC rating by 4 points. But when you add compound with the additional mass, the performance dramatically improves—raising the STC rating 12 points for a single layer of drywall, and 16 points for a double layer. See chart below. Additional STC information can be found in our Test Data section.
- Adding resilient channel or modern sound clips to the wall and then adding drywall is not recommended because this can create a Triple Leaf Effect.

1. Payment Schedule: Client shall be invoiced 100% of total cost of the Security Detail prior to the event, due upon receipt. The remainder of any additional costs shall be invoiced following the security detail to include any additional expenses. Client understands the notated reimbursable business expenses represent an estimate of services and will vary depending on the nature of the applicable expense and the Services. All expenses must be pre-approved by Client in writing, and shall be described in reasonable detail in the invoice with receipts wherever possible. Expenses that are not pre-approved, in writing, by Client are not reimbursable. All business expenses not stated within the parameters of this agreement must be in writing and authorized by both designated representatives. Client agrees to pay all invoices in the full amount without offset of any kind or nature unless there is a good faith dispute concerning the rate or quantity of charges in which event Client agrees to pay the undisputed amount and to notify Contractor as to reason for the dispute and the value thereof. Client understands that local state taxes (i.e., CA) may be applicable as an added charge to the hourly billing rates.

- 2. No Warranty: Contractor shall provide all services consistent with the highest standards of the industry. In accordance with the mandated laws of New York and California, The Department of Consumer Affairs, and the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services, Contractor hereby states all applicable licensing (PPO #14509) and licensing of their Executive Protection Agents are in compliance with the state regulations of New York and California. Contractor provides and maintains insurance to protect against claims for false arrest or theft. Notwithstanding such insurance coverage, Client recognizes that Contractor is not an insurer of property or persons and makes no warranty, express or implied that the Services provided under this Agreement will prevent loss, damage, or injury to Client, any of Client's guests, invitees, employees, or Client's personal or real property, or from the injury or death of any person whomsoever, or the consequences there from, whether arising from third party negligence, intentional acts, or resulting from a third party criminal act.
- 3. Insurance: Contractor shall provide and maintain at its cost broad form commercial general liability insurance with a single limit of not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and Contractor will name Client as an Additional Insured under the policy. This policy shall remain in full force and effect for the time period of the Services provided hereunder. Except as provided in section 4 below, client agrees to assume all risks of loss, damage, or injury to Client, any of Client's guests, invitees, employees, or Client's personal or real property, or from the injury or death of any person whomsoever, or the consequences there from, whether arising in negligence of a third party, an intentional acts of a third party, or resulting from a third party criminal act.
- 4. Indemnification: Contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Client, its agents and employees from or against any loss, damage, injury, judgment, liability, claim, lien or cause of action, including attorneys' fees and/or costs, for injury to person or property, or death of a person (collectively hereinafter "Claims"), but only to the extent that such Claims arise out of the performance of Services under this Agreement and were caused by the negligence or willful acts of Contractor, its employees or agents or caused by them while acting within the course and scope of their duties and authority under this Agreement. In no event shall Contractor be liable for any Claims caused in so far as they were caused by acts or omissions, or willful misconduct of Client or his respective employees or agents. Client shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Contractor, its agents or employees from and against any and all Claims resulting from the active or passive negligence or willful misconduct of Client in connection with the performance of its services hereunder, including any non-standard services (i.e., not specified herein) performed by Contractor at the request, direction of Client. - 5. Entire Agreement. No understandings, agreements, representations expressed or implied, exist between the Client and Contractor unless expressly specified in writing herein. - 7. Number of Personnel: The Client acknowledges that he has consulted with Contractor for determining the number of Agents that will be deployed for this detail.
- 8. No Guaranty: The Client acknowledges the services provided by Contractor are to provide executive protection agents and advisory services. Security Agents presence is designed to deter and reduce certain types of conduct and risks. However, contractor is not a law enforcement agency. - 9. Equipment: Equipment issued to executive protection agents that may be required by the Client or suggested by Contractor and approved by the Client shall be at the sole expense of the Client, except for uniforms and personal accessories such as firearms. - 14. <u>Waiver</u>: The failure of any party at any time or times to require performance of any provision hereof shall in no manner affect the right at a later time to enforce the same. No waiver by any party of any condition, or of the breach of any term, agreement, covenant, representation or warranty contained in this Agreement, whether by conduct of otherwise, in any one or more instances, shall be deemed to be or construed as a further or continuing waiver of any such condition or of the breach of any other term, agreement, covenant, representation or warranty other term, agreement, covenant, representation or warranty of this Agreement.
- 15. <u>Invalidity of Provisions</u>: The invalidity of all or any part of any provision of this Agreement shall not render invalid the remainder of such provision or any other provision of this Agreement.
- 16. <u>Entire Agreement</u>: This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement and understanding of the parties in respect of the transactions contemplated hereby and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous negotiations, promises, covenants, agreements, representations, arrangements, undertakings and understandings relating to the subject matter hereof. No representation, promise, inducement, or statement of intention has been made which is not embodied in this Agreement.
- 17. <u>Choice of Law</u>: This Agreement shall be governed by, interpreted, and construed and enforced in accordance with the domestic laws of the State of California without reference to principles of conflicts law. Contractor and Client consent and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the State of California, for the adjudication of any dispute between Contractor and Client that arises out of or relates to this Agreement or its subject matter. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement or its subject matter shall be settled by binding arbitration heard by one (1) arbitrator, in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules ("Rules") of the American Arbitration Association. The arbitrator shall be appointed in accordance with the Rules. The parties hereto agree that the venue of such arbitration shall be California. EACH OF THE PARTIES HEREBY KNOWINGLY AND PURPOSEFULLY WAIVES ITS RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL RELATING TO ANY DISPUTE, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THIS RELEASE OR ITS SUBJECT MATTER.
