Noise Management on inside/outside of Premises:

- Ensure all doors and windows are closed at or within approved times as permitted under Community Board 3 recommendations.
- Ensure that all door and windows are closed in the event or expectation that noise levels will exceed above the parameters laid out by community board 3.
- Keep music at appropriate levels at all times.
- Post "respect your neighbors and local residents" notices outside premises.
- Make phone numbers and/or contact information of principles available to neighbors and relevant community associations.

Vehicular Traffic and Sidewalk Management:

- Limit side-walk obstructions, for example, sandwich boards advertising sports events, menu's etc.
- Post "Respect your neighbors/local residents" notices outside direct vicinity of the premises.
- Ensure that both security and principals monitor all street-frontage relative to the bar to minimize and limit any potential disturbances to neighbors.
- Security and principals will ensure no lines or congregations of people be allowed gather outside the bar at any time.
- Ensure all patrons to the front of bare area maintain an orderly conduct during the permitted times for which French doors are open
- Have CCTV activity monitor entrance and store front at all times.
