

Patron Control

We are a refined but casual concept. We anticipate a steady flow of patrons for both food and beverage but not a large influx at one time. There will be a sit down bar for anyone waiting for a table, as well as for dining.

Although we will not be taking reservations, we will have a seating hostess that will also be implementing a "NoWait" text message waitlist system. This will be if there is a wait longer than 15 minutes to avoid lines, loitering or side walk congestion.

Noise Control

Music will be amplified by small restaurant speakers with no subwoofers and will be kept at a minimal background and conversational level. The ceiling of the venue will have installed diffuser panels to reduce noise generated by conversations. In order to manage outdoor noise we will discourage patrons from lingering outside with a text message waitlist system and a dedicated employee to ask guests to not congregate on the sidewalk. We will also have conspicuously posted "Respect our neighbors" signs.

Traffic Control

This is a local restaurant located directly on First Avenue. We anticipate the majority of patrons to come from the neighborhood and therefore not generate many taxi drop offs or pickups. We will however have a dedicated employee to ensure that there is no avoidable congestion.
