VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND CROWDS MANAGEMENT PLAN

The roads are one way and there is parking on both sides of the road as well as a municipal parking lot 100 feet away from the establishment. So we do not expect to see much vehicular traffic. In regards to street traffic we will be implementing a wireless standby service. This way our patrons will be notified via text when their tables are ready and thus do not need to inhibit foot traffic by standing outside the establishment.

NOISE MANAGEMENT PLAN

-We have several factors that work in our favor in terms of volume control. The first is that our establishment will only be playing background music, there will be no dancing. So the worry of having club music spilling out to our neighbors will not be a concern. Second, the bar is located in the lower level of the building. So any noise will not directly be heard on the ground level. Finally, we plan to do a bit of soundproofing to the establishment as we understand the worries of our neighbors and wish to be mindful.
