We plan to focus on providing as wide a range of creative offerings once we reopen to primarily bolster the Performing Arts community and enable us to survive given what we realistically assume will be diminished overall business prospects..

This Application is done in anticipation of lower than expected revenues due to the Covid-19 crisis and its' resultant consequences. Licensee will need to create additional different sources of revenue in order to meet the financial obligations of the premises including maintaining employees, paying all state and local taxes as well as the underlying financial commitments of the enterprise. The wider the range of entertainment offerings availed to the Applicant, the more likely the event the Applicant will survive the current economic catastrophe. Licensee does not have any legal ability to operate outside either on the sidewalk or for Open Streets given that the location is directly behind a bus stop. Licensee has not been able to open in any manner since closing March 12, 2020.

There is currently a legally filed, built, and approved stage which has been in active use in the space for more than 16 years and was used for live rock and roll performances for over 11 years prior to current licensee and until closing hosted world class DJ performances, dance performances, comedy, theater, drag performance, spoken word, cabaret, poetry slam. The performance area and seating is in full compliance with all local requirements and is on the approved Public Assembly Approved Plans. The unique layout, location and high level soundproofing of the premises provides complete soundproofing. Applicant is able to provide professional crowd control given that the performance stage and flex-seating is located in the cellar level with multiple exits and entrances to insure proper crowd control and exterior noise mitigation.

This application is also done specifically given the current SLA guidance, with the requirement that all Licensees have the Method of Operation on the actual License. Not only is this proper by law, it is also necessary to be in full and complete compliance with all SLA rules, given the current heightened scrutiny and enforcement.
