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Cameron Bean, Managing Partner

A resident of Lower Manhattan originally from Atlanta, Cameron Bean is the Managing Partner and sole equity owner of the Crossett Group, LLC. Cameron is committing 100% of his time to the launch, continued operation and management of Cafe Skye.

Cameron currently serves as an Investment Professional at Piney Lake Capital Management LP, a Connecticut-based hedge fund managing over \$500 million in capital. 
EXTERIOR DIAGRAM 43 Clinton Street New York, NY March 28, 2021


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



INTERIOR DIAGRAM – Basement 43 Clinton Street New York, NY March 11, 2021


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




















