



NOTICE of PUBLIC FORUM

Subject: Temporary Closure of West 33rd Street between Tenth and Eleventh Avenues
When : Wednesday, June 24, 2015
Where : 413 Tenth Avenue, at the corner of West 33rd Street
Entrance on Tenth Avenue
Time: 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM

The New York City Department of Transportation (DOT) in conjunction with Hudson Yards Development Corporation (HYDC), proposes to temporarily close West 33rd Street between Tenth and Eleventh Avenues to facilitate the re-profiling of the street which is a component of the Hudson Yards Redevelopment Project. The affected street segment is proposed to be closed July 2015 through Fall 2016. By law all street closures which last longer than 180 days require a public forum (Section 19-107 (b) of the NYC Administrative Code) and the preparation of a Community Reassessment, Impact, and Amelioration (CRIA) statement. The requirement for the issuance of a CRIA statement may be satisfied by the delivery of an Environmental Assessment Statement (EAS), Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) or similar document required by law to be prepared in relation to the street closure. The CRIA or an EAS/EIS should incorporate any public comments and responses received during the public forum.

DOT in collaboration with HYDC will be holding this public forum to present information about the temporary street closure. Members of the public and affected Community Board(s) and elected official(s) are invited to attend and will be given the opportunity to make comments. This forum complies with Local Law 24 of 2005 (Title 34, Chapter 2, Section 2-16 of the Rules of the City of New York).
