ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING RULES SUSPENSION CALENDAR The City suspends alternate side parking (ASP) rules on legal and religious holidays. On major legal holidays (those with a **), stopping, standing and parking are permitted except in areas where stopping, standing and parking rules are in effect seven days a week (e.g., "No Standing Anytime"). Parking meter regulations are also suspended on major legal holidays. On all other holidays, only street cleaning rules are suspended, all other regulations remain in effect. There are four (2) dates in February 2014: 2/12 (Wed.) and 2/17 (Mon.).

BREWER STEPS UP STREET-LEVEL ANALYSIS OF TRAFFIC DANGERS TO HALT FATALITIES To help put an end to the city's tragic traffic fatalities, Borough President Gale Brewer has called on Manhattan Community Boards to identify and submit lists of their top traffic hotspots. She used the list at her first meeting of the Borough Service Cabinet on Thursday, January 30, 2014 to ensure specific problems get specific solutions. Given that the CB's are closest to the ground in each neighborhood, they are in a key position to report on problems in their jurisdictions. Her office will cross-analyze the data using all available metrics, and follow through with City agencies. Solutions would include improving signage and signals, fixing dangerous traffic patterns, and stronger enforcement of speed limits.
