At its January 12th meeting, the Business Licenses & Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted 5 to 1 to recommend approval of an on-premises liquor license for the above applicant.

This approval is contingent on the applicant's agreement to the following stipulations which should be attached to the liquor license.

The applicant shall:

- 1. Install the air conditioner for the premises with an insulated jacket and sound baffles sufficient to keep operational noise at a minimum.
- 2. Close the doors to the garden and prohibit patron use after 10 P.M. on week nights (Mondays through Thursdays) and after 11 P.M. on weekend nights (Friday through Sunday).
- 3. Provide indoor space for garbage storage and not use the garden for that purpose.
- 4. Refrain from playing music, or having music audible in, the back yard.
