Dear Commissioner Kelly,

At its June 10, 2003 meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 heard the application by Luna Rossa Restaurant LLC d/b/a Cascina, 647 Ninth Avenue (45<sup>th</sup>/46<sup>th</sup>), for an alteration to its on-premises liquor license.

The Committee recommended approval of this alteration contingent on the applicant's agreement to the following stipulation, which should accompany the altered liquor license.

- Applicant stipulates that during the installation of all new ceilings at the premises he will install fiberglass insulation between beams, then soundproofing material, and finally two layers of sheetrock to cover the materials.

Manhattan Community Board No. 4 approved this recommendation, with the above stipulation attached, at its July 30 meeting.
