At its June 18, 2003 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed plans for an unenclosed sidewalk café.

No one appeared in opposition to the application. However, there is heavy pedestrian congestion at the north-west corner of 44th Street and Ninth Avenue and the sidewalk café, as proposed, would further impede pedestrian flow. Accordingly, the Committee voted to approve the application for the sidewalk café with the following stipulations:

- 1. The applicant agrees to remove 2 tables and 5 seats from the Ninth Avenue side of the café and reconfigure the café so that only one row of tables remain along Ninth Avenue; the placement of the outer railings would reflect the reduced footprint of the cafe.
- 2. The revised plans must indicate the width of the service aisles and width of tables along 44th Street and along Ninth Avenue.

Please find enclosed an agreement signed by the applicant to revise plans as stipulated herein. With these revisions, the application was approved by this Board's Executive Committee. The Full Board will vote on this application on July 30, 2003.
