At its May 5, 2004 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed plans for an unenclosed sidewalk café. Although there were no complaints regarding the restaurant it self, the Board has received several complaints regarding noise and crowds gathered on the street at the adjacent night club, which shares the same address as the restaurant. In order to limit sidewalk congestion, the Committee voted to approve the application for a sidewalk café, provided that a stipulation be attached to the permit requiring the café to close one hour earlier than DCA guidelines require.

On May 5, 2004 the Full Board approved the application for an unenclosed sidewalk café in accordance with the Transportation Committee's provisions.
