**Re: A & A Catering d/b/a Turkish Cuisine, 631 Ninth Avenue (44/45)**

Dear Chairman Kelly,

At its meeting on May 11, 2004, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 heard the application of A & A Catering, d/b/a Turkish Cuisine, 631 Ninth Avenue (between 44<sup>th</sup> and 45<sup>th</sup> Streets) to alter its restaurant wine license. The alteration consists of the addition of 10 tables, with seating for 20, in the backyard of the restaurant.

The Committee voted to recommend approval of this alteration on condition that the owner agree to the following stipulation which shall be incorporated into the license:

- Patron use of the backyard shall end and the outdoor space shall be closed at 10 P.M. on all nights of operation.

The applicant has agreed to this stipulation. If this operation goes smoothly during its first year and does not disturb the restaurant's neighbors, the applicant may return to the Committee to request an extension of service hours.

At its June 2 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted to recommend approval of this alteration with the stipulation above incorporated into the license.
