At its June 16, 2004 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed plans for an unenclosed sidewalk café. No one appeared in opposition to the application. Therefore, the Committee voted unanimously to approve the application for renewal of the sidewalk café with one stipulation:

- The café's outer boundaries will be marked on the sidewalk, as required by DCA's sidewalk café regulations. If markings are not in place when the applicant returns to the Board for renewal, this committee will recommend denial of the renewal application.

On July 7, 2004 the Full Board approved the application with the above stipulation by a vote of 35 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstaining and 0 present but not eligible to vote.
