At its July 27, 2005 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed plans for an unenclosed sidewalk café. No one appeared in opposition to the application, and the Board office has no record of problems with the applicant. The Committee voted to approve the application for a new sidewalk café with the following stipulations:

• The café's outer boundaries must be marked on the sidewalk, as required by DCA's sidewalk café regulations. If markings are not in place when the applicant returns to the Board for its next renewal, this committee will recommend denial of the renewal application.

On July 27, 2005 the Full Board approved the application with the above stipulation.
