Dear Commissioner Kelly,

At its June 14, 2005 meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to recommend approval of an on-premises liquor license for 127 M2M Inc., 127 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

This recommendation is contingent on the owner's agreement to incorporate the following stipulations into its method of operation on its New York State Liquor Authority Application:

- 1. Should noise become a problem, owner agrees to hire a reputable sound-engineering firm and implement all its recommendations so that noise from the venue shall not disturb the neighborhood.
- 2. Owner agrees to provide and maintain adequate security personnel outside his premises.
- 3. Owner agrees to maintain clean and orderly streets at all times in front of and nearby his premises.

At its full board meeting on July 27, 2005, Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to approve this recommendation with the above stipulations attached.
