Dear Commissioner Kelly:

At its October 6, 2005 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted to recommend approval of the on-premises liquor license for Guntherlee Inc., a restaurant at 815 9th Avenue (at 54th), New York City.

This recommendation is contingent on the owner's agreement to incorporate the following stipulations into its method of operation on its New York State Liquor Authority Application:

- French doors will never be open later than 8pm.
- No loud music will be audible on the street at any time.

Several neighbors of this establishment appeared at the Business Licenses & Permits Committee meeting on September 13 and expressed concern about the French doors. Music and patron noise spilling out onto the street from open French doors late at night has been a serious problem at other establishments in the past. This is a busy and well-populated block, with many people who would be affected by noise from this establishment. Therefore, it is very important that the proprietors adhere to this agreement.
