Re: Request by Red Cross for Authorized Parking on West 49th Street (10/11)

Dear Director Martell:

At its October 19, 2005 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee voted unanimously to support a request from the New York Chapter of the American Red Cross for dedicated parking space in front of its new headquarters on West 49th Street between 10th and 11th Avenues. The signage would designate the space in front of the building and driveway (approximately 2 parking spaces) as "Parking for Red Cross Vehicles Only". It is our understanding that a similar parking provision has been provided by DOT at the present Red Cross headquarters on West 66th Street. The Committee was pleased to support this request in view of the essential services provided by the Red Cross.

On November 2, 2005 the Full Board of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted unanimously to support the Committee's recommendation.
