On November 16, 2005, the Transportation Planning Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 voted to support a request from the manager of a small bed and breakfast to install "No Standing Anytime" signs in front of his building at 131 West 23rd Street. The petitioner contacted your office in February of 2005 regarding this issue and was denied a hotel loading zone because there are relatively few transient rooms at this bed and breakfast. His subsequent request for a "No Standing" zone was referred to the Community Board.
