At its November 16, 2005 meeting, the Transportation Planning Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 reviewed the above Street Activity Permit application. Some committee members expressed concern that the expenditures submitted by the applicant were not presented in great enough detail. Given the long-standing presence of this well-attended street activity, the committee voted to approve this application with the stipulation that in future years, the applicant will provide the Board with detailed financial information. Furthermore, the Committee added the following stipulations:

- The applicant must post signs at both ends of the street fair indicating the name of the community organization benefiting from the street closing.
- The applicant must post bus re-routing information at all affected bus stops.

On December 8, 2005, the full Board voted to recommend approval of this application.
