At its November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2005 meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to recommend approval of a on-premises liquor license for 453 West 17<sup>th</sup> Street Corp, 453 West 17<sup>th</sup> Street, NY, NY. The applicant plans to operate a bar/restaurant with a "dueling pianos" theme.

This recommendation is contingent on the owner's agreement to incorporate the following stipulations into its method of operation on its New York State Liquor Authority Application:

- 1. 453 West 17<sup>th</sup> Street Corp, 453 West 17<sup>th</sup> Street shall keep its doors and windows closed to avoid noise traveling outside.
- 2. Management will work actively to address and correct traffic congestion and related problems on 17<sup>th</sup> Street.
