At its February 15, 2006 meeting, Manhattan Community Board No. 4's Transportation Planning Committee heard from the above applicant and reviewed plans for an unenclosed sidewalk café. The Committee voted to approve the application for a new sidewalk café with the following stipulation:

On March 1, 2006 the Full Board approved the application with the above stipulation.
