Re: Access-a-Ride Signs in front of the Veterans Outpatient Clinic, 437 West 16th Street

Dear Mr. Schiavone:

Manhattan Community Board 4 requests Access-a-Ride signs in front of the Veterans Outpatient Clinic associated with the New York Harbor Healthcare system.

The clinic is a federally funded clinic, which serves veterans from the Korean, Vietnam and Iraq wars. Many patients are handicapped and require ambulatory assistance to visit the clinic for medical treatment. The clinic currently serves approximately 150 patients a day, most of who arrive via shuttle van or Access-a-Ride.

The clinic has been in the building for approximately eleven years and has renewed its lease for another ten years. In the past, parking space was plentiful on this block; but now a large condominium is being built on the west and a music venue has opened to the east, creating a parking shortage that causes serious difficulties for the veterans and the clinic. There is not even one handicapped parking on the entire block. Currently, there is an existing curb cut in front of the clinic entrance.

We are therefore asking the MTA to install Access-a-Ride signs in front of the Veterans Outpatient Clinic at 437 West 16th Street for the full width of the building. The signs should prohibit parking or standing from 6:30 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Saturday and on holidays. Once the signs are installed, the Veterans Clinic will paint a yellow line on the curb between the two signs.
