On March 21, 2007, the Chelsea Planning and Preservation Committee of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 considered the application by Equinox pursuant to Section 73-36 of the Zoning Resolution for a permit to operate a Physical Culture Establishment at 450 West 17<sup>th</sup> Street. The Committee voted unanimously to approve with the condition that special discount offers be given to those residents in the affordable units.

On April 4, 2007, following a duly noticed public hearing, the full Board at its regular meeting, voted to approve the special permit by a unanimous vote.

This Board has reviewed the Statements of Facts and Findings in the application and agrees that the proposed facility meets the requirements for the requested special permit.

The subject PCE is expected to operate on a seven day per week schedule. The intended hours are from 5:30 am to 11:00 pm from Monday to Thursday, 5:30 am to 10:00 pm on Friday, and 7:00 am to 9:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday. They anticipate that approximately 1100 patrons will use the facility on a daily basis and that the majority of members will reside or be employed in the neighborhood.
