We would thus like to request installation of bus shelters with seating at the following locations:

9th Avenue and West 25th Street
9th Avenue between 15th and 16th Street (new installation)
9th Avenue between 17th and 18th Street (new installation)
9th Avenue and West 27th Street
30th Street and 9th Avenue (new installation)
46th Street and 9th Avenue (new installation)
47th Street and 10th Avenue
50th Street and 10th Avenue
9th Avenue between 51st and 52nd Street (new installation)
9th Avenue between 54th and 55th Street (new installation)
10th Avenue between 54th and 55th Street
8th Avenue and 25th Street (new installation)
8th Avenue and 30th Street (new installation)
8th Avenue and 50th Street (new installation)

The following existing shelters are in need of repair or replacement:

53rd and 10th Avenue
57th and 10th Avenue
57th and 9th Avenue

50th and 9th Avenue
46th and 9th Avenue
42nd and 9th Avenue
