Dear Commissioner:

At its July 18, 2007 meeting, the Business Licenses and Permits Committee of Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to recommend denial of a new liquor license for **190 Restaurant Corp/Havanah Chelsea**, unless the following conditions are incorporated into the methods of operation of the license:

- The consumption of alcohol in back yard outdoor space will be only via seated food service.
- The back yard outdoor space will not allow standing space for patrons to drink/smoke.
- There will be a maximum of 8 tables with no more than 2 persons at any one table in the outdoor space. The outdoor space will not allow more than a total of 16 patrons at anytime.
- There will be no blocking of egress (e.g., fire escapes) of adjacent buildings.
- The back yard outdoor space will be closed and vacated by 10 pm on Sunday through Thursdays and 11 pm on Friday and Saturday.
- The applicant and his staff will enforce a quiet environment in the outdoor space, so as not to disturb nearby residents (e.g., there will be no amplified music, as per the law).
- Neighbor complaints will be resolved by applicant in a timely manner and in coordination with Manhattan Community Board 4.

At its full board meeting on July 25, 2007, Manhattan Community Board 4 voted to approve this recommendation.
