Dear Ms. Gotay:

Manhattan Community Board 4 recommends denial of the application for a new unenclosed sidewalk café unless the following stipulations are met:

- Two (2) tables and four (4) chairs on the avenue and eight (8) tables and sixteen (16) chairs on West 21<sup>st</sup> Street against the wall of the building;
- Two/three person wait staff for the sidewalk cafe;
- Café will close at 11:00 p.m. seven (7) days a week;
- No amplified music or audio television sports broadcasts at any time if the exterior doors on 21<sup>st</sup> Street are open;
- Adequate monitoring of sanitation; and
- No use of any sandwich boards because these are illegal.

The stipulations reflect the efforts of the Quality of Life Committee in tandem with community residents to arrive at a reasonable solution to community concerns.

We continue to request that the outer boundaries of cafes be marked on the sidewalk, as required by Department of Consumer Affairs' sidewalk café regulations.
