ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING RULES SUSPENSION CALENDAR The City suspends alternate side parking (ASP) rules on legal and religious holidays. On major legal holidays (those with a **), stopping, standing and parking are permitted except in areas where stopping, standing and parking rules are in effect seven days a week (e.g., "No Standing Anytime"). Parking meter regulations are also suspended on major legal holidays. On all other holidays, only street cleaning rules are suspended, all other regulations remain in effect. There are three (4) dates in September 2012: 9/3** (Mon.), 9/17 (Mon.), 9/18 (Tue.) and 9/26 (Wed.).

LESS TELEPHONE BOOTHS The current contract between New York City and telephone booth operators expires in 2014.
