Manhattan Community Board 4 Sidewalk Obstructions Reporting Protocol 2016

Whenever your right of way is excessively encroached upon by furniture and other hazards, follow these steps:

- 1- **First occurrence**: Call 311¹ to report using the following specific terms
 - a. For <u>Storm enclosures/Vestibules</u> that exceed 18" in depth, use the term "*structures constructed/placed without a permit*". This is enforced by the Department of Buildings.
 - b. For <u>A Frames-Sandwich boards</u> which are all illegal no matter where they are placed use the term *"Illegal A- Frames"*. This is enforced by the Department of Sanitation. For Best result, report also directly to the Sanitation Website ²
 - c. For <u>sidewalk cafés</u>, which exceed their footprint or have furniture out when not in use (night or winter), use the term "*sidewalk café*", "*illegally placed furniture*", "*furniture not stowed when not in use*". This is enforced by the Department of Consumer Affairs.
 - d. For <u>Out of Order bicycles</u> use the term "*derelict bicycle*". This is enforced by the Department of Sanitation.
 - e. For <u>all other furniture or obstacles</u> use the term "*sidewalk obstruction*". This is enforced by the Department of Sanitation.

2- Second Occurrence

Call 311 to report again with same language and forward your 311 complaints to MCB4³ for the District Manager to escalate with agencies.

3- Third Occurrence

Call 311 to report again with same language <u>and</u> Request a meeting with the MCB4 Quality of Life Committee

4- On going

Continue to call 311 at every occurrence until resolution.

Make sure <u>all affected neighbors</u> follow the same procedure(s) as complaints from a sole person may be dismissed. Take pictures, video or sound recordings to attach to the complaint(s).

It may take a while to resolve, but MCB4 is committed to help improve its residents' quality of life.
