



Dear Chairman Rosen:

Manhattan Community Board 4 (MCB4) recommends denial of a new restaurant wine and beer license for **Enologo**, unless the following stipulations, agreed to by the applicant, are part of the method of operation for this establishment:

- Hours of operation will be no earlier than 11:00 am and no later than 2:00 am Sunday through Wednesday and no earlier than 11:00 am and no later than 3:00 am Thursday through Saturday.
- There will be no use of any outdoor spaces (rooftop, patio or sidewalk café).
- The operator is not applying for a cabaret license.
- The applicant stated they will have background music playing in the restaurant.
- There will be French doors and/or windows that open to the street front. Applicant has agreed to close them by 10:00 pm Sunday through Thursday and 11:00 pm on Friday and Saturday. They will also be closed whenever amplified sound is played inside, as per law.
- There will be absolutely no use of delivery bikes.
- Kitchen exhaust will exit through ventilation above the highest floor of surrounding buildings and be constructed in a manner to not disturb neighboring residents or offices. Additionally it will be compliant with NY DOB code.

- Applicant will not install a storm vestibule enclosure that will project more than 18 inches as per DOB code. Storm enclosures can only be used between November 15th and April 15th.

A signed copy of the stipulations agreed to by the applicant is enclosed. This application is for a new restaurant. Total capacity is 74 patrons with 12 seated at 5 tables.


