12 Manhattan Community Board 4 (CB4) writes to pursue addressing possible changes to  
13 the boundary lines of the 13<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct to coincide with community district  
14 boundaries.

15  
16 Currently the 13<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct covers a small portion of Chelsea, mostly from West  
17 14<sup>th</sup> Street to West 26<sup>th</sup> Street, from Sixth Avenue to Seventh Avenue. The 13<sup>th</sup> Police  
18 Precinct's office is located in at 230 East 21<sup>st</sup> Street quite a distance from the above  
19 referenced blocks. For years, residents of these blocks have expressed concern about  
20 inadequate service and delayed response time to emergencies. CB4 believes these blocks  
21 would be better served by the 10<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct, located at 230 West 20<sup>th</sup> Street in the  
22 Community District 4 (CD 4).

23  
24 New York City's Charter mandates establishing community board boundaries to be  
25 coterminous with the local city service offices. The City's Charter Commission will be  
26 addressing possible changes to the City Charter this year.

28 CB4 would appreciate the opportunity to discuss further with the appropriate person the  
29 process for effectuating this change.
