11	Manhattan Community Board #4 requests that the parking regulations on the south side
12	of West 17 <sup>th</sup> Street between 6 <sup>th</sup> and 7 <sup>th</sup> Avenues that currently read "No Standing, Except
13	Commercial Vehicles 3 hour limit, M-F 8am to 6pm (with meters)" be changed to regular
14	meter parking M-F 8am to 6pm with a 1 hour limit.
15	
16	The South Side of West 17 <sup>th</sup> Street between has a variety of businesses. Toward the west
17	there a several smaller eclectic retail stores including a dry-cleaner/tailor, flower shop,
18	thrift store, psychic (who probably predicted this proposal), dermatologist/spa, and
19	jewelry shops. The parking regulations in front of these buildings are for commercial
20	vehicles, likely reflecting retail business needs at other times. The Chelsea Council of
21	Block Associations along with one of the businesses surveyed the existing retail tenants
22	who all concurred that, given their clientele and more limited delivery needs, customer
23	parking would be preferable to delivery parking. We are thus making that request to
24	DOT.
25	
26	We should note that, particularly on the western portion of the block where there is a
27	church, a school and the Rubin Museum, the parking regulations are different and are not
28	proposed to change.
29	
30	We appreciate the efforts of the Chelsea Council of Block Associations in surveying the
31	businesses and request that DOT make this requested change that will benefit both the
32	retail businesses and local residents.
