


WHY IS THIS PROJECT NECESSARY?



CONNECTING TO 3RD WATER TUNNEL SHAFTS


- ✓ New York City's water distribution infrastructure is aging and in need of repair and upgrades.
- ✓ To accomplish this, the City of New York has constructed a new water tunnel, City Tunnel No. 3.
- ✓ The <u>W. 48th Street</u> project is one of 11 such planned projects in Manhattan that will connect new shaft distribution chambers to City Tunnel No. 3.
- ✓ Upon completion of these chambers, the City will be able to activate sections of the new tunnel #3 and begin rehabilitating City Tunnel Nos. 1 & 2.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Connect to 3rd Water Tunnel Shaft
- New trunk and distribution water mains Including:
 - o 48", 36" and 30" trunk mains
 - o 24", 20" and 12" distribution mains
 - o Valves, regulators & chambers



SCOPE OF WORK (cont'd)

- Installation of 48", 36" and 16" sewer pipe
- Private utility upgrades
- Pedestrian ramps at corners (based on field conditions)
- Reconstruction of curbs & sidewalks in certain locations (some areas will be pigmented concrete and granite curb)
- Some new traffic signal and street lighting poles

- Test pits 48th between 10th and 9th avenues
- Rodent baiting
- Tree pruning
- Establish contractor storage areas

- Existing sewer replacement 48th street between 8th avenue and
- Broadway and between 9th and 10tyh avenues
- New 20 inch water main installation on 48th between 8th and Broadway
- 48 inch trunk main excavation intersection of 48th and 10th avenue.

Phase II

- Existing sewer replacement 51st street between 9th and Broadway
- Replacement




PROJECT LOCATION: STARTING WORK LOCATIONS:

Storage Location West 48th Street Between 10th and 11th Avenue.



PRELIMINARY SCHEDULE: WORK HOURS / SPECIAL NOTES


7AM – 10PM: Monday – Friday (<u>Allowable Hours</u>)

COMMUNITY IMPACTS

Office of Community Outreach & Notification

- Pedestrian access to buildings will be maintained at all times.
- ☐ MTA Bus stops (M11, 20, 50, 104) may need to be relocated within construction zones. (advanced notice will be given)
- Uniformed NYPD Traffic Agents assigned for traffic control.
- Certain operations will be noisy; DDC will monitor operations and work within DEP Noise Code regulations.
- Merchant deliveries and drop-offs may be affected. Coordination will be necessary in some areas and addressed on a case by case basis (CCL will be in contact with those affected).




COMMUNITY IMPACTS (Cont'd)

Office of Community Outreach & Notification

- Driveway/loading dock access may be temporarily restricted while a street is under construction (coordination will be arranged on a case by case basis).
- Parking may be temporarily restricted
 - Signs will be posted where necessary and advance notification provided.
- □ Garbage/Trash pick up will be affected. CCL will assist with coordination between public and DOS or Private Carters

Water Service Interruptions:

- Prior day advance notice will be provided
- Specific instructions will be provided prior to water shutoff
- ☐ If your water service is not restored within 3 hours of the time indicated on the Shutoff Notice, please contact the Community Construction Liaison (CCL) or 311 if after hours.

Special Needs:

- Individuals with special needs should contact the CCL
- DDC field staff will work specifically with those individuals to minimize the inconvenience

Rodent Control:




