It has come to the attention of Manhattan Community Board No. 4 that Drive In 24 LLC d/b/a Drive In Studios, located at 443 West 18th Street, has been operating as an occasional nightclub and causing severe crowd control problems on 18th Street. We ask that the Tenth Precinct not allow further use of this space to serve alcohol, and ensure that all activities at this location are in compliance with the law

Although Drive In Studios is a photo studio, neighbors appeared at the September and October meetings of the Board's Business Licenses & Permits Committee to complain about chaotic street conditions caused by occasional special events held at the studio. They brought photographs with them that bore out their complaints.

We believe that special events use of this space is in violation of the building's Certificate of Occupancy, and is also inappropriate given the residential nature of the area. Please do not allow any further temporary liquor licenses to be obtained at this location. We would also appreciate any efforts to control conditions on this street..
