THE PROPOSED CO-LOCATION OF A NEW PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL, SUCCESS ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL – IN MANHATTAN 2. On September 21, 2012, the New York City Department of Education (“DOE”) proposed to site the kindergarten through fifth grades of Success Academy Charter School – Manhattan 2. That proposal was scheduled to be considered by the Panel for Educational Policy (“PEP”) on November 8, 2012. The DOE is now re-issuing the proposal in the wake of disruptions caused by Hurricane Sandy; this re-issued proposal will be subject to a vote at the PEP’s meeting on December 20, 2012. Success Academy Charter School would co-locate with Business of Sports School, an existing high school that serves students in grades nine through twelve; High School of Graphic Communication Arts, an existing high school that serves students in grades nine through twelve; Urban Assembly Gateway School for Technology, an existing high school that currently serves students in grades nine through ten, and an Alternate Learning Center, which provides an educational setting for students in grades nine through twelve who are on a Superintendent’s suspension for up to 90 days in building M625, located at 439 West 49th Street, New York, NY 10019 in Community School District 2. A “co-location” means that two or more school organizations are located in the same building and may share common spaces like auditoriums, gymnasiums, and cafeterias.
