Dear Friends,

On behalf of Community Board Six, I would like to wish everyone a Happy Summer. As is our procedure, Full Board and most committees do not meet in July and August to give our volunteer members a well-deserved break. There will be some meetings, however, including Business Affairs and Street Activities, the Executive Committee, and in July the Land Use, Waterfront Committee. Please consult the calendar for times, locations and days, since there may be changes.

While students are out for the summer recess, a new high school – the Academy for Software Engineering - is about to open at the Washington Irving Campus near Gramercy Park. This small school received 800 applications for 200 seats in the first class, proving that there is a great demand for such programs. After seeing the demand City Hall has announced that it hopes to open other similar schools to help prepare our young people for jobs in the digital world.

We recently received a brief letter from the Department of Design and Construction informing us that the second east-west water main for the Third Water Tunnel, shaft site 33B will be installed on East 58<sup>th</sup> Street between Second and Third Avenues, over the objections of Community Board Six and virtually everyone in the neighborhood. Work is expected to start more than likely during the summer of 2013 after the East 59<sup>th</sup> Street main is completed; which means that the community will suffer through more than a decade of chaos, noise, utility interruptions and inconvenience. The City never responded to our letter of December 2011, or to the arguments that proved the initial route was still the best. Therefore to ensure everyone has input, look for a public hearing notice on this matter in early Fall.
