Participate in a
CENTRAL PARK USER SURVEY AND COUNT

The Central Park Conservancy seeks volunteers to participate in a major Park-wide user survey and count in July. Volunteers will:

- Conduct interviews of Park users
- Count Park users
- Work a total of eight hours in two-hour shifts that can be spread over four days
- Receive training



The survey dates are:

- **Sunday July 13, Tuesday July 15, Thursday July 17, and Saturday July 19**

The training dates and times are:

- **Saturday June 28 from 10-11:30 AM and Monday June 30 from 6:30-8 PM**

This survey and count will be the most comprehensive study of Park use since 1982, when the Conservancy created the management and restoration plan for Central Park. This will also be the first year-round study with additional surveys and counts to take place next October, February, and April.

This project coincides with the 150th Anniversary of the Greensward Plan, the original design for Central Park. This is an opportune occasion to look back, take stock of the Park in the present, and prepare for the future. We know that the Park is used by more people and in more ways than ever before. The more specific information gathered during the survey and count will help us to better serve the public during our ongoing restoration and management of the Park.
