### How to get from the **1** 66 St-Lincoln Center station to the **1 2 3** 72 St-Broadway station

Take the **M7** from Broadway and 65 St to Amsterdam Av and 72 St.

Take the **M104** from Broadway and 65 St to Broadway and 73 St.

Take the **M5** or **M5 Ltd** from Broadway and 65 St to Broadway and 72 St.

### How to get from the **1 2 3** 72 St-Broadway station to the **1** 66 St-Lincoln Center station

Take the **M104** from Broadway and 72 St to Broadway and 66 St.

Take the **M5** or **M5 Ltd** from Broadway and 72 St to Broadway and 66 St.

### Hours of operation for bus routes

The **M7** (northbound) and **M104** run 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

The **M5** and **M5 Ltd** do not run during the late night hours. Please take the **M7** or **M104**, instead.
