### RIVERSIDE CENTER PUBLIC HEARINGS

On May 24, the City Planning Commission certified an application for the “Riverside Center,” a proposed 8-acre development between West 59th and 61st Streets and West End Avenue and Riverside Boulevard. In the first phase of public review, Community Board 7 has 60 days to hold hearings and make recommendations.
