Increase Pedestrian Safety

Calm Traffic

W. 155th STREET (EDGECOMBE AVENUE TO ST. NICHOLAS AVENUE)  
ST. NICHOLAS PLACE (151st STREET TO 155th STREET)

Simplify Traffic Movements

Increase Green Space

NYC DOT will implement safety improvements along W. 155th St., between Edgemcombe Ave. and St. Nicholas Ave.:

- Construct 4 pedestrian safety islands and 6 new crosswalks on St. Nicholas Place
- Install 8 sidewalk extensions
- Add greenery
- Restrict specific turns to improve traffic flow and reduce conflicts

Implementation starts Late-June
