We're looking for performers, songwriters, dancers, writers and activists – **young women ages 12 through 21 only**. Young women of all backgrounds, abilities, gender expressions, ethnicities, languages, races, sexual orientations, religions, and nationalities are strongly encouraged to audition.

To request a 5-minute audition slot, e-mail a photo, resume, and note with why you want to be part of Girl Be Heard to auditions@girlbeheard.org. You do not need to have a professional photo or resume to be considered.

For the audition, please prepare a short piece (2 minutes or under) -- **written by you, in your voice** -- addressing an issue you are passionate about. This could be a song, poem, scene, or spoken word piece that shows us who you are and what is important to you. Feel free to move and shout. You do not need to memorize this piece. Your slot will include your performance of the work and a brief interview.
